**Mission**

Bumi Bwesu Youth Centre is dedicated to promoting the sexual and reproductive health of youth and vulnerable people of all ages in Nchelenge District, Luapula Province, Zambia. Our goal is to reduce gender-based violence (GBV), improve the quality of family life, and prevent HIV and other sexually transmitted infections. Bumi Bwesu conducts sensitizations on GBV in the community and in schools, counsels and guides survivors of GBV, communicates information about Family Planning to village men and women, provides HIV Voluntary Counselling and Testing, and promotes women's economic empowerment by providing partnering with non-profit oriented microcredit organisations.

**Specific Objective 1**

*Increase awareness through campaigns addressing youth, school and the adult community against the prevailing tide of tolerance toward gender-based violence in all its mild and extreme forms.*
